Contractors working on the Washington Street bridge project accidentally cut into a Jamestown Board of Public Utilities District Heat pipe, causing a shut down of service to District Heat customers in the area until repairs are completed. The cut in the pipe occurred between 12:30 noon and 1 p.m. today.

District Heat customers affected include those buildings on Harrison and Steele Streets and areas south of Steele Street. Facilities such as the Boys' and Girls' Club, St. James Church, St. Susan Center, Heritage Park and the Lutheran Social Services buildings on Crane and Chandler Streets are affected by the shutdown until the repair is completed.
