## Jamestown BPU Home Energy Audits and Weatherization Rebates for Residential Customers



## BPU Home Energy Audits and Weatherization Rebates

The BPU offers residential electric customers the opportunity to request a subsidized energy audit for their apartments or homes. Two audits are available from which to select. A Level One Audit is intended for apartments and newer or recently remodeled homes. A Level Two Audit is intended for older homes that are more likely to benefit from weatherization improvements. Following each audit, customers will be provided with suggestions to reduce home energy usage and may qualify for weatherization rebates recommended by the Level Two Audit.

### How do I participate in an audit?

All customers qualify for a Level One Audit. Customers must own the property being audited for a Level Two Audit. Contact the BPU's Energy Efficiency Coordinator at 661-1646 to make sure you qualify and to schedule the audit that is best for you.

### How much will my audit cost?

The customer's cost for a Level One Audit is \$50. This represents a savings of approximately \$100 when compared to the normal charge for this type of audit.

The customer's cost for a Level Two Audit is \$100. This represents a savings of approximately \$200 when compared to the normal charge for this type of audit.

The customer share must be paid before the audit is performed. Customers must wait 24 months before requesting another Level One or Level Two audit.

### How do I qualify for BPU weatherization rebates?

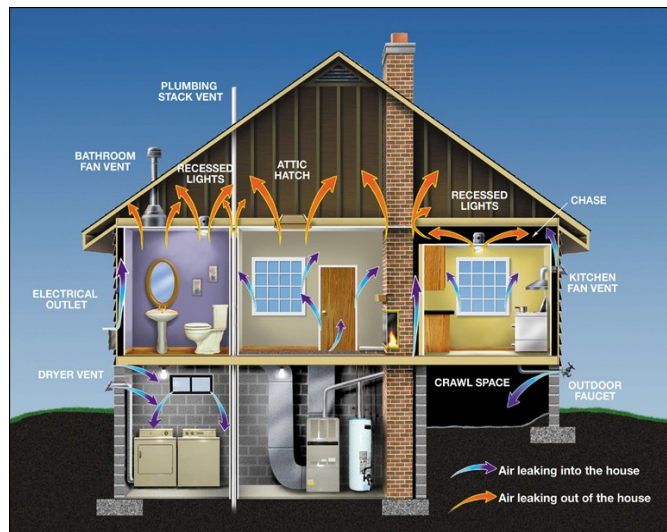
Only homeowners who have completed a Level Two Audit qualify for weatherization rebates. However, all BPU residential electric customers may participate in the Energy Star Rebate Program without an audit. Rebates may only be claimed in one program.

## Level One Audit

### A Level One Audit will:

- Identify cost savings of converting to compact fluorescent and hard-wired fluorescent lighting
- Evaluate hot water tank and pipe insulation
- Identify cost savings of installing energy saving showerheads and aerators
- Identify cost savings of installing a programmable thermostat
- Evaluate clothes dryer for proper venting and energy usage
- Evaluate energy usage of refrigerator and freezer
- Carbon monoxide safety monitoring
- Safety check of all gas appliances
- Provide in-home energy education demonstrating how you can double your savings by making small changes in how you use energy

**\*To receive a Level One Audit, customers are not required to own the property.**



## Level Two Audit

### A Level Two Audit will include all of Level One plus:

- Computerized evaluation of "building envelope"
  - Measures current air flow compared to safe/efficient air flow with a blower door test
  - Identifies drafts and air leaks
- Identify cost savings of upgrading insulation
  - Using infrared technology to evaluate wall insulation
  - Hands-on inspection of attic insulation and ventilation
- Combustion efficiency test on gas furnaces and hot water tanks

**\*To receive a Level Two Audit, customers are required to own the property.**

### Weatherization Rebate

- Rebates will cover 25% of the cost of the weatherization improvements with a \$1,000 maximum limit per audit and only one audit allowed per structure.
- Upon verification, rebates will be issued in the form of a check.

### Requirements to receive a weatherization rebate:

- Level Two Audit completed within the last 24 months
- Level Two Audit recommended weatherization improvements must be performed by a Building Performance Institute (BPI) certified contractor
- Provide an invoice from the BPI certified contractor who completed the work
