Board of Public Utilities General Manager Walter Haase, P.E., announced that Jones-Carroll Inc. has qualified for the BPU Economic Development Rider #1 for Service Class #3 electric customers and for Rider #5 – Line Extension – Economic Assistance for its new service.

Jones-Carroll provides waste disposal, collection and recycling services for residential, commercial, industrial and construction customers. It has serviced customers in Chautauqua County, Cattaraugus County and Northwest, PA, since 1990. Jones-Carroll will be a new customer located at 2142 Lodestro Lane, Town of Ellicott, in the Dow Street Industrial Park.

According to Mike Jones, Jones-Carroll President, the company constructed a new 18,000 square foot all metal building with attached Office, to house the new recycling processing (baling) center in Chautauqua County. The recycling processing center will be centrally located within a mile of the County's transfer station.

New equipment for the facility includes a vertical baler, an IPS slider bed conveyor system, a glass crusher and a can densifier. Sorting equipment and other crushing type equipment will be added as the company expands. The State of New York assisted with the investment of equipment.

“The new facility is especially important today because of the high cost of transportation,” said Jones. “It will expand the services Jones-Carroll offers and will allow us to add six new employees over the next five years.”

BPU General Manager Haase stated, “The construction of the new Jones-Carroll facility and the planned expansion of its business is certainly great news for our community. The BPU is pleased to be in a position to help Jones-Carroll grow by utilizing our Economic Development Rates.”
