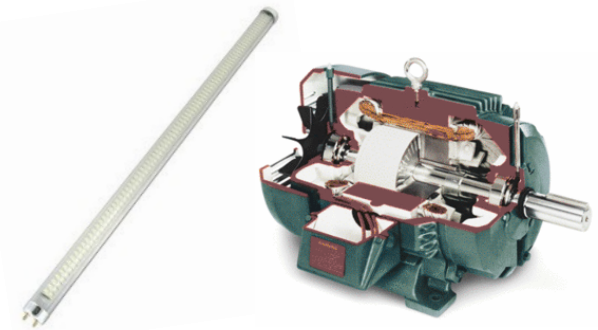

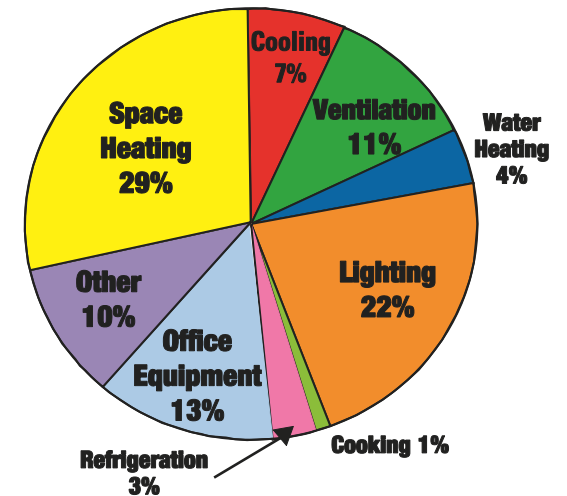

Jamestown BPU Lighting & Motor Rebate Program Updated October 1, 2009

The BPU is offering small commercial and industrial customers financial incentives (rebates) for energy efficiency projects. The program's goal is to promote investment in new high quality lighting and motor equipment that operates at a very high level of electrical efficiency.

Do I qualify?

Commercial and industrial customers whose annual total electric cost is less than \$30,000 qualify.

What is included in the rebates?

The purchase cost of new permanently installed light fixtures, ballasts, bulbs, LED exit signs, occupancy sensors, electric motor and variable speed drives.

What is NOT included in the rebates?

Portable equipment and labor costs to install equipment.

How do I participate?

Visit our website at www.jamestownbpu.com to find out more information and to download a rebate form and qualifying measures worksheet. Forms and worksheets are also available at BPU Customer Service, 92 Steele Street; open 7 a.m.—5:30 p.m. weekdays. Contact the BPU's Energy Efficiency Coordinator, Daniel Reynolds, at 661-1646 if you have further questions.

The BPU recommends that a licensed electrical contractor be contacted to assess the project and develop a proposal for upgrading your facility. Customers must have pre-approval for rebates greater than \$1000.

The Jamestown BPU reserves the right to inspect the work before issuing a rebate.

8' fluorescent T-8, T8 HO, or T-5 fluorescent	New fixtures or retrofit; lamps and ballasts must be new	Up to \$50 per fixture
ENERGY STAR®-labeled LED Exit signs	New ENERGY STAR®-labeled LED	Up to \$25 per fixture
Hard-wired compact fluorescent fixtures	Fixtures must be new	Up to \$25 per fixture
High Bay T-5 fixtures	Fixtures must be new	Up to \$70 per fixture
Occupancy Sensors	Each unit shall be hard-wired, passive infrared and/or ultrasonic. Manual ON override capability are NOT eligible.	Up to \$30 per control

Ballast power consumption in low mode must not exceed 60% of full load. ON/OFF overrides and spaces under 250 sq. ft. not eligible	Up to \$60 per control
Metal Halide fixtures Indoor/Outdoor	Must have pulse-start fixtures and matching lamps	Up to \$60 per fixture
