* Corrugated cardboard consists of two pieces of heavy paper (usually brown) with a wavy layer in between. Moving and mailing boxes are usually corrugated cardboard NOT cereal and shirt boxes. Corrugated cardboard will be picked up at the curb THE SAME WEEK as glass recyclables. Cardboard should be flattened, folded and placed in the yellow container, or if too large, placed in a cardboard box next to the yellow container containing the glass recyclables. **PIZZA BOXES ARE CONSIDERED DIRTY AND SHOULD BE BROKEN DOWN AND PUT IN REGULAR GARBAGE BAGS.**

RECYCLING IS THE LAW !!

1. Garbage and recyclables must be placed at the curb **no earlier than 6:00 PM the evening before** your scheduled pickup.
2. There is a **40 pound weight limit** per garbage bag and/or recycling container.
3. All recyclables must be placed in reusable containers. (Overflow quantities may be placed in additional containers next to the yellow one.)
4. **Remove and throw away** all lids and caps from glass jars and plastic bottles.
5. Residents are allowed to dispose of **one (1) item** (weighing a maximum of 40 lbs. and easily handled by one person) per week such as a small TV, child's riding toy, lamp, etc.
6. **Colored Glass** – discard with your trash. Do not place colored glass at the curb to be recycled.
7. **Corrugated Cardboard** consists of two pieces of heavy paper (usually brown) with a wavy layer in between. Moving and mailing boxes are usually corrugated cardboard NOT cereal and shirt boxes. Corrugated cardboard will be picked up at the curb THE SAME WEEK as glass recyclables. Cardboard should be flattened, folded and placed in the yellow container, or if too large or too many boxes, place in a cardboard box next to the yellow container containing the glass recyclables.
PIZZA BOXES ARE CONSIDERED DIRTY AND SHOULD BE BROKEN DOWN AND PUT IN REGULAR GARBAGE BAGS.

Call 661-1651 to arrange for pickup of large items (mattresses, couches, washers, etc.) for a \$10.00 charge plus the landfill fee. Appliances containing coolant are subject to a \$15.00 coolant removal fee in addition to the pickup charge.

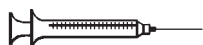
SPECIAL HOLIDAY TRASH DROP-OFF
