PLEASE CONTAIN ALL GARBAGE IN TRASH BAGS --- NO LOOSE GARBAGE.

RECYCLING IS THE LAW!!

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. What items are recyclable?

- a) Paper (newspaper, magazines, junk mail, white envelopes, office paper, school papers, {no construction paper} paperback books, catalogs, phone books)
- b) Glass (clear glass food jars only)
- c) Corrugated Cardboard (2 pieces of heavy paper {usually brown} with a wavy layer in between)
- d) Plastic (tubs, jugs, containers, bottles)...  1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6*new
- e) Metal - aluminum and metal beverage and food cans only

2. Do I need to remove lids & labels?

- a) Lids must be removed and thrown away from glass jars and plastic bottles and jugs and plastic containers. Labels do not have to be removed from plastic, glass or metal cans.

3. What can I do with my recyclables if I need to dispose of them sooner than the BPU collects them?

All recyclables are accepted at no charge at the South County Transfer Station in Falconer which is open Tues. - Sat. from 7 AM to 3 PM.

4. What do I do with pizza boxes?

Pizza boxes are trash and should be placed in garbage bags at the curb. Gift boxes, cereal boxes and pop/beer cartons are trash and are not recyclable and must be contained in bags.

5. How do I dispose of syringes?

- a) Syringes must be taken to the Security Officers' Desk at the Emergency Room Entrance of the WCA Hospital - Monday thru Saturday from 7 AM to 3 PM. (Syringes must be in a closed, plastic container [milk or pop containers].)

Wednesdays - 4 PM to 7 PM & Saturdays – 9 AM to 1 PM

SPRING AND FALL CLEANUP – see reverse side of recycling calendar for dates –

Spring Cleanup - If your **regularly scheduled garbage day is Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday**, place your cleanup items at the curb the same day as your regular pickup during **the first week**. If your **regularly scheduled garbage day is Thursday or Friday**, place your cleanup items at the curb your regular garbage night **the second week**. No recyclables will be picked up during the first week, however recyclables will be picked up during the second week as recorded on this calendar.

Fall Cleanup-one week only - place items at the curb the same night as your regularly scheduled garbage pickup- Recycling will be picked up as usual.

Residents are encouraged not to store junk in their homes, place it at the curb with your regular weekly garbage anytime.
