**FLUVANNA AVENUE YARD WASTE SITE
OPENS SATURDAY, APRIL 11**

The Board of Public Utilities (BPU) Solid Waste Division will reopen the Fluvanna Avenue Yard Waste Site on Saturdays, weather permitting, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. beginning Saturday, April 11, for Jamestown residents.

Waste accepted from BPU sanitation customers at the Yard Waste Site is limited to green waste. Only land clearing debris, tree branches, leaves and brush may be brought to the Yard Waste Site.

In another section of the site, the BPU will continue to accept small quantities of concrete, brick, asphalt pavement and soil.

Wood and construction debris is no longer accepted and may be taken, instead, to the Ellery Landfill or the Falconer Transfer Station for disposal for a slight fee.

These guidelines are established by the State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC).

Brown yard waste bags are available at the BPU Customer Service Department, open 7 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. weekdays, at 92 Steele Street. The 30-gallon bags cost \$10 for four bags, which includes home pick-up service.
