UNPAID WATER CHARGES<sup>1</sup>:

Unpaid water charges in excess of 60 days will be reported by April 1 of each year and subsequently placed on customer's tax bills. The Village shall include the past due amounts on the tax bills to the property owners and shall pay the City the past due amounts within sixty (60) days of receipt thereof by the Village.

<sup>1</sup> *The Village agrees to reimburse the City for any reported individual water or sewer bills unpaid by any user within the Village for a period in excess of sixty (60) days after the due date of such bill as follows: by April 1 of each year, the City may report the unpaid bills to the Village on a list containing a description of the property served sufficient to identify it, the tax map number, the names of the persons or corporations liable to pay for the same, and the amounts chargeable. The Village shall include the past due amounts on the tax bills to the property owners and shall pay the City the past due amounts within sixty (60) days of receipt thereof by the Village. Nothing in this paragraph shall be read to restrict the rights of the City to collect past due amounts through normal collection procedures, including service disconnect.*
